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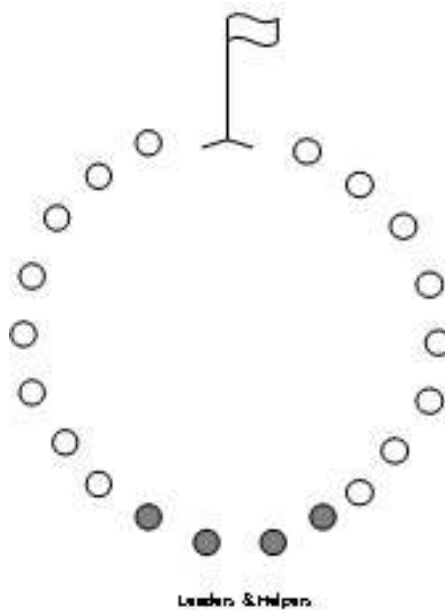
## OPENING PARADE

### Preparation for Opening Parade

Ensure that the Australian flag is correctly folded for breaking, and is hoisted to the masthead by the Leader before parade is called.

**Leader:** *"Joey Scouts on Parade"*

**Joey Scouts:** Form a circle  
(Leaders and Helpers join the circle)



**Leader:** *"Joey Scouts - Alert"*

**Leader or a Joey Scout:** Breaks the flag

**Leader:** *"Joey Scouts - Salute"*

**Leader:** *"Prepare for Prayer"*

**Leader: "Joey Scouts" *Break off***

All Joey Scouts and leaders turn to the right and move off.

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## **Game Balloon Name**

Equipment Balloons

Game Play Joey Scouts stand in a circle; Leader throws a balloon up in the air and calls a Joey Scouts name. He/she must run into the centre, hit the balloon and call someone else's name. Continue until all have had a turn.

## **Guest Speaker RSPCA or Vet**

Ask a representative from the local RSPCA or local Vet to come along to Joeys to talk about looking after pets

This can be a great lead into the Joey Scouts collecting pet food that can be handed over to the representative or a visit to the RSPCA or Local Vet can be arranged and the food collected handed over then.

## **Game Potato Relay**

Equipment Newspaper rolls  
Potato's

Game Play In teams. Relay race with sticks (newspaper rolls) and odd shaped potatoes. Joey Scouts roll potato to end, round chair, and back to team and pass stick to next in line. Make sure both potatoes are oddly shaped!

## **Game Celebrity Heads Activity**

Equipment Peak Caps  
Labels with various names - Suggestion characters include: Pluto (Dog), Sylvester (Cat), Tweetie (Bird), Mickey Mouse (Mouse), Tigger (Tiger), Poo Bear (Bear) etc.  
Double sided tape – stick labels to hats  
Chairs for the three 'celebrity's'

Game Play Select up to three Joey Scouts to be the contestants – they have to guess what name is on the head band they are wearing. Contestants ask questions in order to determine who they are. The remaining Joey Scouts respond to the questions – yes, no.

## **Game Find A Group**

Equipment Nil

Game Play Leader calls out a number and Joey Scouts have to form groups of that number.  
*Variation:* This may also be played as *shapes*.

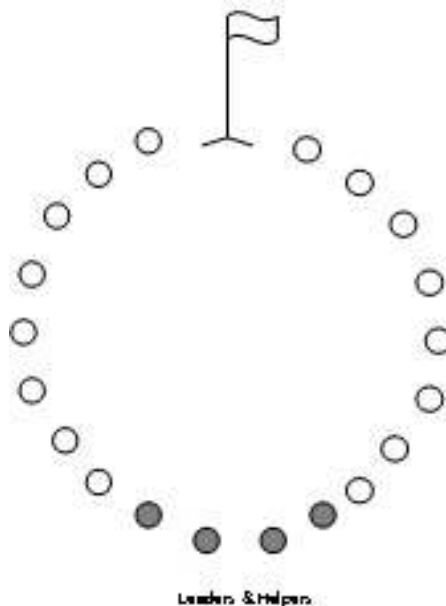
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## Closing PARADE
