Explanation of Activities:

Colour in Australia Flag: Colour in a Picture of the Australian Flag.

Name Ball: Get the Joeys to sit in a circle on the floor, get them to take it in turns to roll the ball to each other stating off with “my name is ...”, then go onto “my name is ... and I am passing the ball to ...”

Bags: Make a shoulder bag out of tarp cut into pieces. Punch holes in the sides and either tie a bow or tread twine through holes. Use the edging of the tarp to make shoulder straps with the edging of the tarp.

If time discuss what would need to be packed for a round the world trip.

Passports: Make passports by putting together a cover card and internal pages. Get the joeys to complete their personal information on the front page, take a passport photo of each joey. Let them know that there photos will be processed and given to them next week.

If time discuss who has a passport and why it is needed to travel overseas.

Itinerary: Each joey is given a world map. The countries that are planned to go to are then marked one by one on the map and a flight path drawn on the map. The map can then be coloured in.

Discussion on where going how we would go about getting to all these places and have a look at the world globe.

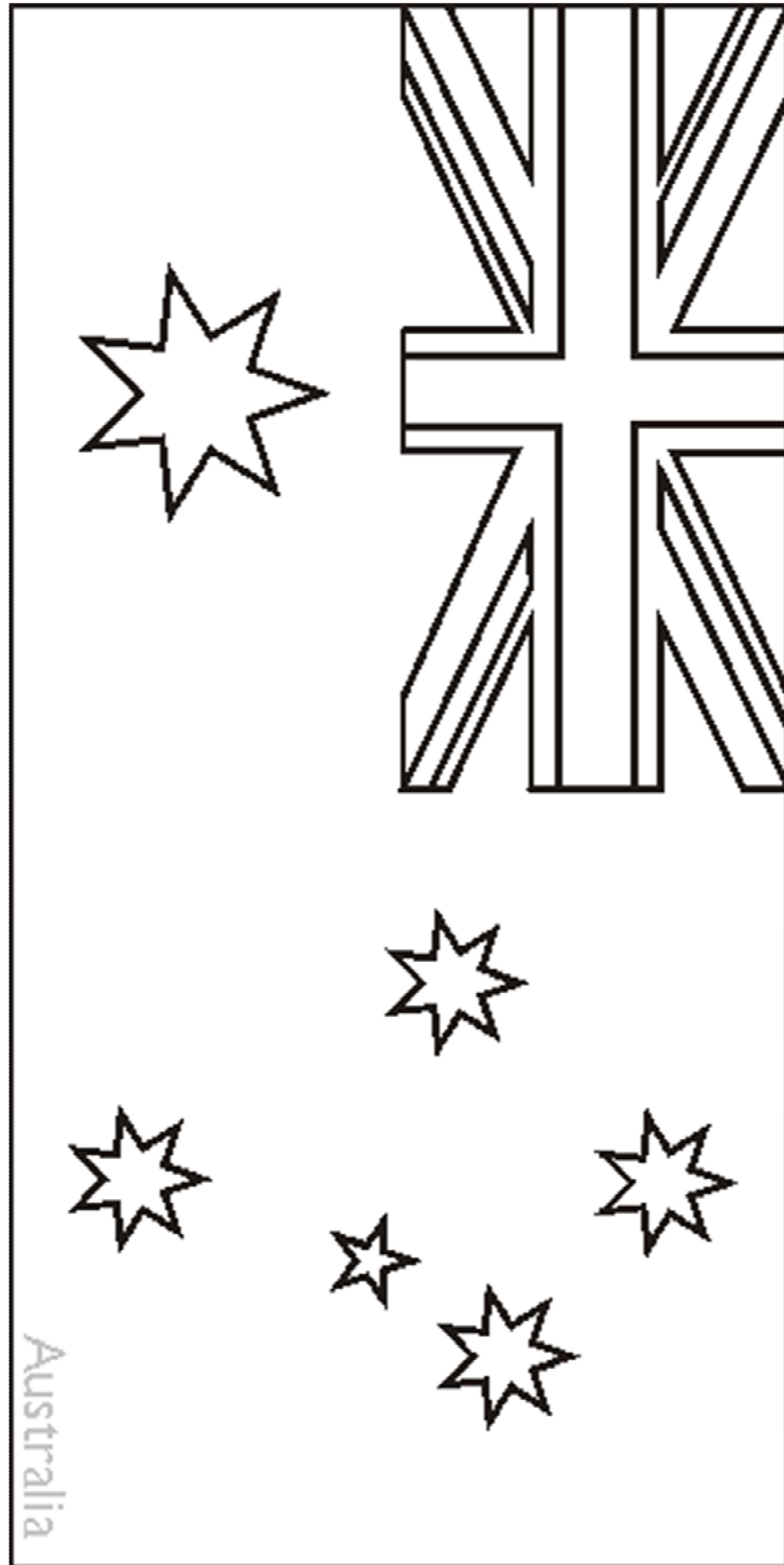
Departure: Leave Australia through Customs and get departure sticker for passport.

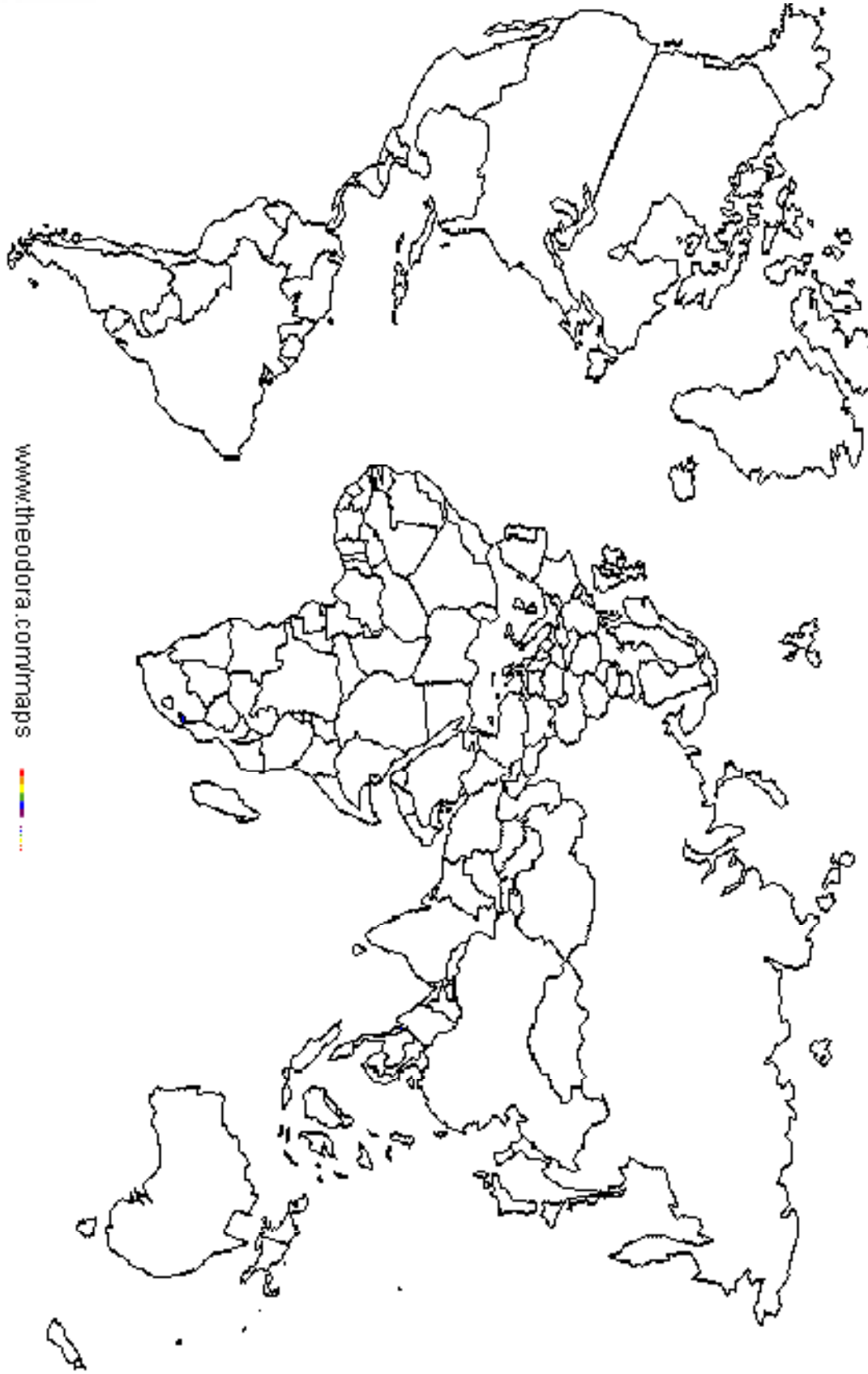
