Joey Scout Action Environment Story Pond Life

Items needed: Pictures of pond animals – Tadpoles, Water snails, ducks, fish, frogs and dragon flies. These are to be handed out to the Joeys who then sit in a circle on the floor. Leader reads the story with one hand raised. When the Joeys creature is mentioned, they run up and tag leader's hand then return to their spot on the floor. When word Rubbish is mentioned they must all fall on their backs and play dead until the next creature is mentioned.

When I was walking to the pond the other day someone had dropped RUBBISH on the footpath so I picked it up and put it in the bin. Then a **DUCK** flew over my head, followed by a beautiful **DRAGONFLY**. When I reached the pond I saw lots of animals swimming around and sadly quite a lot of RUBBISH. I could see some tiny **TADPOLES** swimming about in the water trying not to get caught in the **RUBBISH** or eaten by the **DUCKS**. I could see **WATER SNAILS** climbing up the water reeds looking for their lunch and I could hear **FROGS** croaking and saw them hopping over **RUBBISH** to reach their lily pads. A family of **DUCKS** was quietly floating past looking for some lunch; I hope they don't eat any of the **RUBBISH**.
