ACTIVITY 1	Planning	MINUTES - 15
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Equipment: Litter bag for each Scout, gloves, torch (head torch if possible), Street map

Method:

- Each Patrol should plan a journey around local streets which will end back at the den and mark on their map plus the master map to be left in the hall
- The journey for each Patrol should cover different streets and directions
- Planning time should be about 10 minutes

ACTIVITY 2	Litter Clean up	MINUTES - 60
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Equipment: Litter bag for each Scout, gloves, torch (head torch if possible), Street map

Method:

- The duration of the cleanup should be at least 1 hour
- Scouts can pre-sort litter as it is located or bundle all litter into the same bag for sorting on return to the Den
- It would probably work best if sorting is carried out after the cleanup when back in the den with good lighting.

Note : Care must be taken to ensure against injury from sharp objects, e.g. needles, glass etc. Gloves must be worn at all times.

ACTIVITY 3	Sorting	MINUTES - 15
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Equipment: Extra bags or bins, disinfectant hand wash

Method:

- Sort litter appropriately and dispose of into wheelie bins or skip for next collection day

ACTIVITY 4	Reporting	MINUTES - 10
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After completion of sorting each Patrol prepares a report to present to the Leaders and the Troop. The PL or a volunteer may present this report. Open discussion should be encouraged.
