 (Leaders and Helpers join the circle)

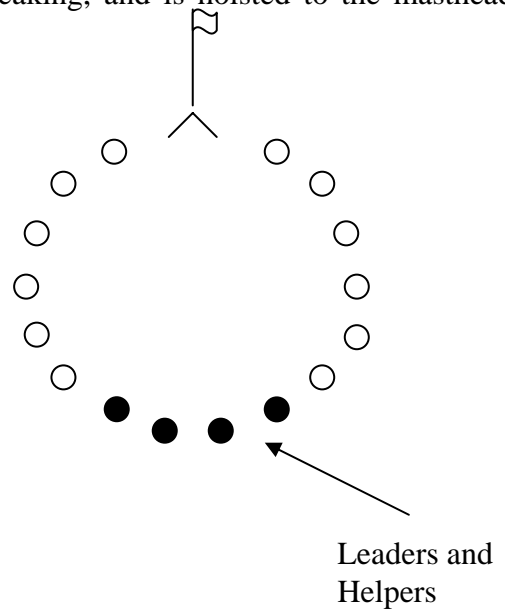
Leader: “*Joey Scouts - Alert*”

GAME 1	Leap Frog Relay	MINUTES - 5
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Method:

Relay game

The Joeys form 2 teams standing in single file with each Joey about 2 metres apart.

Joeys bend down with hands on knees to make themselves as small as possible.

The last Joey in each line leap frogs over his team members until he reaches the front. Then he squats and yells "Go" for the new last Joey to begin.

CRAFT	Frog Hand Puppet	MINUTES - 15
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Make a paper bag hand puppet in the shape of a green frog.

Need:

- Paper bags
- Sheets of green, red, black and white paper
- Template shapes cut out of cardboard for tracing shapes (see pattern below)
- Pencils
- Glue
- Scissors

Method:

For the basic paper bag – choose one option:

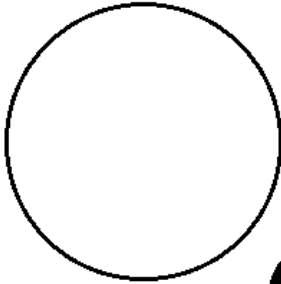
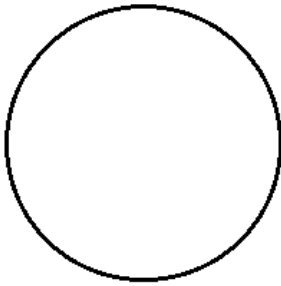
- Use a brown paper bag that can be painted green (this is the messy and slowest option), and glue on a green face flap
- **or** glue green paper on face of a brown paper bag – paper is longer than the bag so that it can be folded forward to form the face flap,
- **or** make a green paper bag with 2 sheets of green photocopy paper glued together with one sheet folded over the top of the other so that it forms a face flap

Use template to draw shapes for eyes, arms, feet and tongue onto the coloured paper. Then cut out these shapes. Glue eyes, tongue, arms and feet to the basic paper bag body.

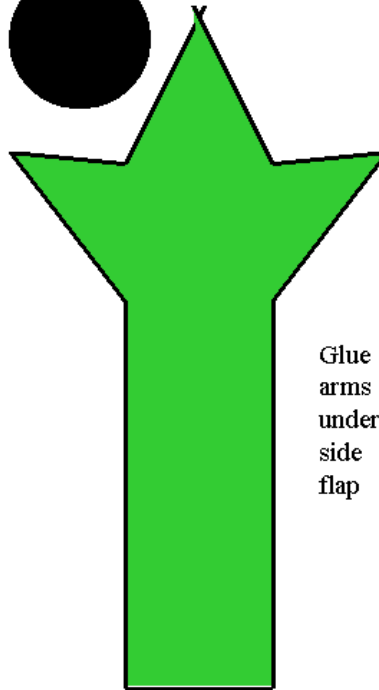
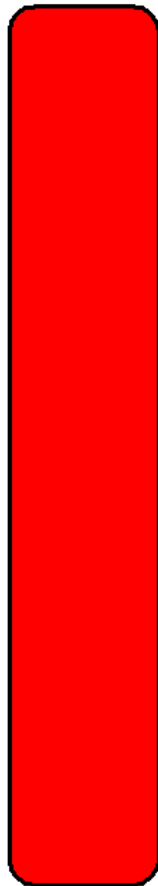
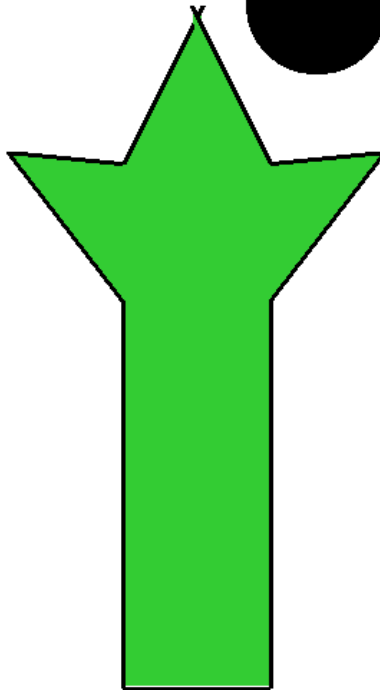
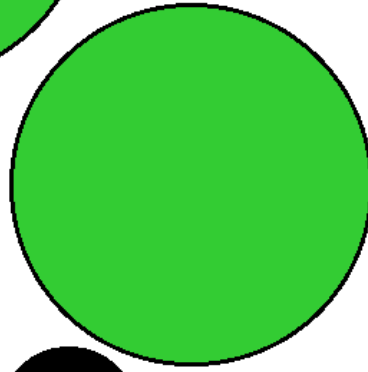
Set aside to dry ready to use during the sing song later.



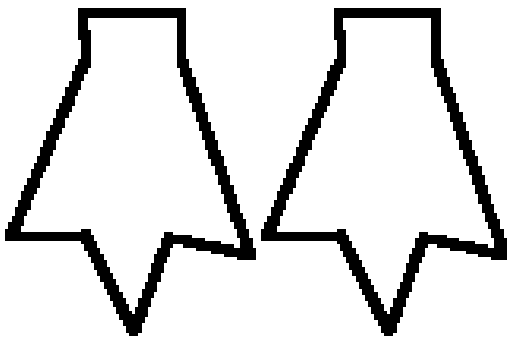
Glue circles together to form eyes

GAME 2	Musical Lily Pads	MINUTES - 5
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Need:

- Cut out at least one lily pad (out of poster paper or newspaper) for each Joey.
- Music machine

Method:

Arrange lily pads in a circle, and turn on some music.

Joeys frog hop around the outside of the circle until the music stops.

Then they try to get to a lily pad.

As with "regular" musical chairs, you can play several different versions:

- One lily pad per person so no one is eliminated,
- The "classical" game where there is one less lily pad than child so one person is eliminated each time,
- Or take away one lily pad each time (but not children) so the froggies have to share lily pads, until eventually all the froggies are trying to stand on one lily pad.

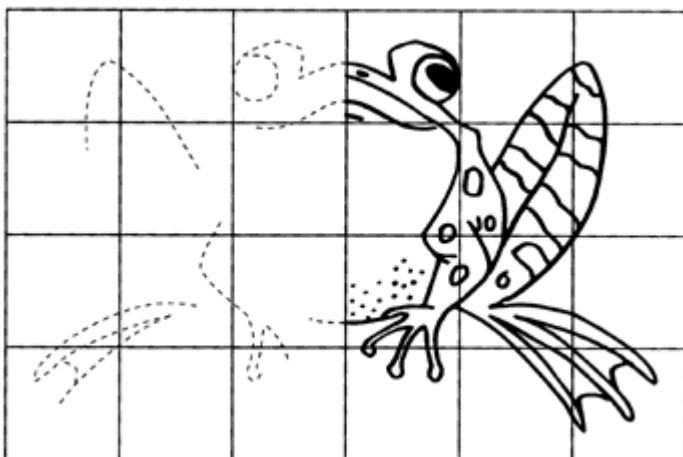

GAME 3	Hopping Frogs	MINUTES - 5
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Need:

Green Balloons on end of string

Method:

Everyone blows up a balloon, ties a string around the balloon and his ankle leaving about a half a metre or so of string between his ankle and the balloon. When everyone is ready, Joeys frog hop about and try to break each other's balloons by hopping on them, but also try to keep from losing their balloon - if their balloon breaks, they may try to break other Joey's balloons- but the "winner" is the one who has his balloon unbroken.

GAME 4	Parachute Froggy	MINUTES - 5
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Need:

Parachute (a sheet or blanket can be used in place of a parachute)
One, two or three green balloons with Froggy faces drawn on them

Method:

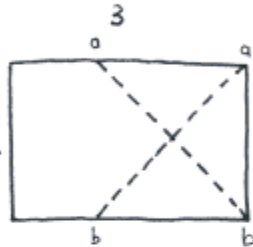
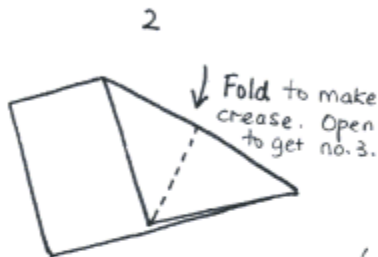
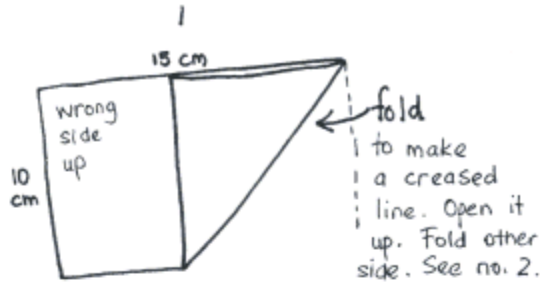
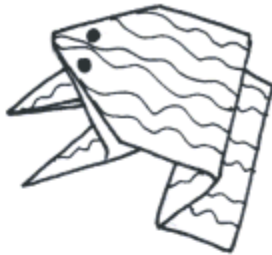

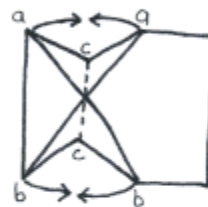
ground is the pond. As the lily pad "waves" around, try to keep the frog on the lily pad and out of the pond.

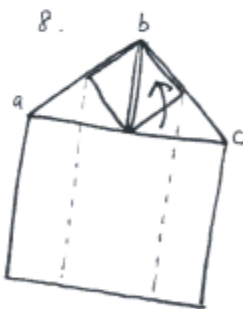

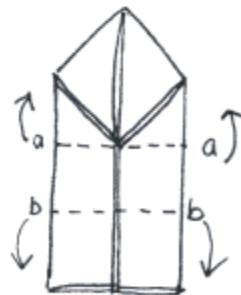
